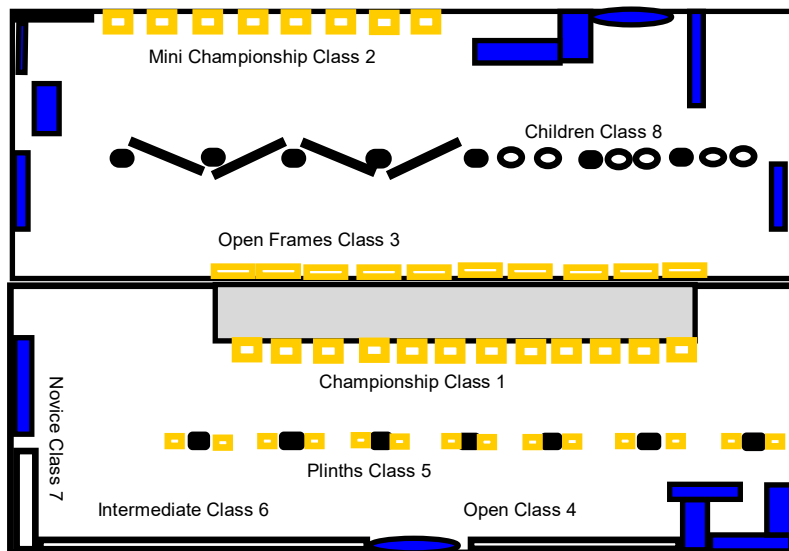

FLORAL DESIGN COMPETITION SCHEDULE

FLORAL DESIGN CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 1. "Outback Sunset" Floor design

- Design to interpret the above theme, viewed and judged frontally and must be staged on the floor
- The allotted space is 1 mt. square, no height restrictions but must have a minimum height of 1.5mt. To be displayed against a black background
- Exhibit may be staged between 7.30am and 3.00pm on Thursday 11th July 2019

Prizes: 1st....\$350 2nd....\$250 3rd....\$150

FLORAL DESIGN MINI CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 2. "Exploring the Reef" Floor design

This class is for exhibitors who have never exhibited in a championship before. Exhibitor may have a mentor, rules apply*

- Design to interpret the above theme, viewed and judged frontally and must be staged on the floor
- The allotted space is 80cm square, no height restrictions but must be have a minimum height of 1mt, to be displayed against a white background
- Exhibit may be staged between 7.30am and 3.00pm on Thursday 11th July 2019

Prizes: 1st....\$150 2nd....\$100 3rd....\$75
\$25 will be paid to all exhibitors, other than prize winners to defray the cost of materials.

OPEN SECTION

Class 3. "Twister"

- The exhibit is to be designed to hang in a supplied, rectangular frame, measuring 180cm high x 80cm wide
- The allotted space is 80cm
- Horticulture materials must predominate
- To be viewed and judged frontally with a white background

Class 4. "Down to Earth" - Tapestry

- To be viewed and judged from the front, (container will be supplied)
- To be staged on a black covered bench with a black background
- Allotted space is 30cm x 30cm width, dried materials allowed

Class 5. "Scenic Rim"

- To be staged on a black covered plinth (30cm x 30cm width) x 90cm height
- To be viewed and judged from the front and sides, allotted space is 60cm

Prizes (Classes 3,4 & 5): 1st....\$100 2nd....\$75 3rd....\$50

INTERMEDIATE

Class 6. "Will O the Wisp"- Cascade

- To be staged on a black covered bench with a black background
- Allotted space is 80cm

Prizes: 1st....\$75 2nd....\$50 3rd....\$25

NOVICE & FIRST TIME EXHIBITORS SECTION

Class 7. "Red Centre"

- To be staged on a black covered round table with a black background
- Allotted space is 60cm

Prizes: 1st....\$50 2nd....\$30 3rd....\$20

CHILDREN UNDER 12 YEARS AND UNDER

Class 8. "Great Balls of Fire"

- To be staged on a black covered round table to be viewed all around
- Allotted space is 60cm

Prizes: 1st....\$30 2nd....\$20 3rd....\$10 HC....\$5

ALL TABLE EXHIBITS WILL BE STAGED ON BLACK CLOTH WITH EITHER A BLACK OR WHITE BACKDROP.

CLOSING DATE FOR ALL ENTRIES IS FRIDAY 21ST JUNE 2019. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Judging will take place at 4pm Thursday 11th July, 2019.

STAGING AREA WILL BE CLOSED TO EXHIBITORS FOR JUDGING AT 4PM THURSDAY 11th JULY 2019.

Competitors in previous novice and intermediate sections, who have won two first prizes in the sections are required to advance to the next classes.

COLLECTION OF EXHIBITS is on Sunday ONLY between the hours of 4.00pm and 4.30pm at the Nambour Showgrounds, downstairs Pavilion.
