

Queensland Garden Expo Butterfly Competition



ENTRY CONDITIONS

- Entries are limited to one entry per person. Only one entry per person can be submitted.
- Your decorated wooden butterfly must be waterproof and able to be displayed outdoors.
- Wooden butterflies must be decorated to redeem entry ticket.
- Your butterfly should not be extremely top or front heavy.
- The entrant represents and warrants that the work is the entrant's sole original.
- All designs must use the butterfly shape blank supplied by the Queensland Garden Expo.
- Butterflies will be placed in groups around the Showgrounds at the organisers discretion.
- Entry Forms must be received no later than Friday May 10th 2024.
- All Entrants must collect their butterfly shaped blank to paint / decorate from the Nambour Showgrounds on either Thursday May 16 (12pm - 4pm) or Friday May 17th (9am - 1pm). Wooden blanks will not be delivered to any participants.
- All completed butterflies must be delivered to Nambour Showgrounds, Coronation Ave, Nambour on Monday 1st July and Tuesday 2nd July 2024 between 8am and 4pm. Please take these to the Main Gate entrance off Coronation Avenue – you will be directed on where to exchange for a ticket by gate personnel.
- Queensland Garden Expo entry passes, (1 for each entry), will be available at Nambour Showgrounds for collection when the completed butterfly is delivered.
- Judging will take place on Thursday 4th July, 2024. The judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Prize Money will be awarded in 3 categories: Most Creative: 1st Prize \$150 / 2nd Prize \$75, Best Use of Recycled Materials: 1st Prize \$150 / 2nd Prize \$75, Best 40th Anniversary Celebration themed: 1st Prize \$150 / 2nd Prize \$75.
- Prize money will be paid via pre-paid Visa Card. These can be collected at the event or will be posted after the event.
- Butterflies cannot be collected before Monday 8th July. Butterflies can be collected between the hours of 9am and 1.00pm on Monday 8th July and Tuesday 9th July. Queensland Garden Expo cannot be responsible for butterflies not collected by this date (unless by prior arrangement). All entries become the property of the organiser if not collected by 1pm Tuesday 9th July 2024.
- Queensland Garden Expo will endeavour to ensure that all butterflies are secure and maintained in good condition but cannot take any responsibility for any loss or damage.
